POSTPONEMENT OF THE 49TH LDC GRADUATION CEREMONY

Warm greetings from the Law Development Centre (LDC)!

We wish to inform you that the 49th Graduation Ceremony, which was slated to take place on 20th May 2022, has been postponed to a date which shall be communicated in due course.

The ceremony has been postponed because the term of the outgoing Management Committee expired on 15th April, 2022 before the Committee could approve the academic results that were being processed. The Management Committee is a critical part of LDC's governance structure under the LDC Act, 1970. It is charged with the administration and management policy of the LDC; among such duties is to approve academic results.
