DELAY IN ISSUANCE OF TRANSCRIPTS AND CERTIFICATES

The delay in the issuance is due to a number of factors key of which include:

1. The service provider, based abroad, rebranded and got new management which affected their processes and procedures.
2. Change in the format of LDC's academic documents as a result of the introduction of classification of the Diploma in Legal Practice.
3. Administrative challenges in coordination between LDC and the service providers.
